<p>Question: How should we classify the socket-outlet (adaptor / tap off unit) for use in combination with a Power Track System according to IEC 60884-1, Table 20? (see pictures attached). Should it be classified as a:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Portable accessory (Test current for temperature rise: 16 A) - Fixed accessory (Test current for temperature rise: 22 A) <p>Decision: The opinion is that this socket-outlet (adaptor/tap-off unit) shall be classified as a fixed accessory and, as far as applicable, as an adaptor.</p> <p>Explanatory notes: The socket-outlet (adaptor/tap-off unit) is intended for use in combination with the Power Track System according to EN 61534. The Power Track System is part of the fixed installation.</p>
