Requirements for Manufacturers

(as per Article 9 of the Agreement)

1. The manufacturer shall carry out routine and random checks in order to ensure that the product for which he has obtained the license for using the CCA EMC Mark, constantly conforms to the prototype that had been tested for obtaining the mark (e.g. checks of the components used for RFI suppression, circuit layout, etc.). Records of these checks shall be kept for review by the Certification Body inspector.
2. If minor modifications are introduced, that may influence the EMC behaviour of the product, the manufacturer shall inform the Certification Body, shall review product compliance and, where necessary, shall repeat the EMC tests before continuing the use of the Mark and shall keep evidence of such tests for the inspector of the Certification Body.
3. If major modifications are introduced, the Certification Body shall be informed and product compliance shall be reviewed and the tests shall be repeated before the Mark can be further used.
