Question			
<p>Some luminaires, e.g. for bathrooms, are provided with socket-outlets. These socket-outlets differ from country to country. VDE is not in the position to decide which socket-outlet will be acceptable in other countries. What has to be done with ENEC approvals? VDE has the opinion that ENEC approval can be issued for such luminaires under condition that socket-outlet for other countries are excluded. It is possible to declare several socket-outlet on the list of components, but only in responsibility of the manufacturer. The Certification Body may carry out, in this case, a check in the scope of market surveillance. What is the opinion of all signatories of the ENEC Agreement?</p>			
Decision			
<p>The ENEC mark can be granted to all kinds of luminaires which comply with the standards as mentioned in Annex B to ENEC 301. In the common format for the licences, that a CB sends to the other signatories of the ENEC Agreement, all the information must be given with regard to the design of the luminaires. An additional possibility is that the CB, that grants the licences, also checks the alternative range of socket-outlets.</p>
