<b>Question</b>			
<p>Is it relevant to require additional marking <b>“Only for indoor use”</b> for all ordinary luminaires?</p>			
<b>Decision</b>			
<p>No. The requirement is not required for <b>all</b> types of ordinary/indoor luminaires. The clause 3.3.10 applies only in cases, where the design of the luminaire could be mistaken for outdoor use. Marking under clause 3.2 is mandatory for all luminaires. Marking under clause 3.3 is only required in special cases to ensure proper installation, use and maintenance.</p>			
<b>Explanatory notes</b>			
<p>This information is relevant for street and floodlight luminaires, where the allowable 10° C temperature reduction for outdoor use has been applied.</p>
